14-15 Uhr Angela Glajcar spricht in der Kappelle über ihre Kunst

Sculptural Installation in the Saint Joseph Memorial Chapel

German artist Angela Glajcar [<http://www.glajcar.de>] will create a monumental, curving, floating sculpture of torn fiberglass fabric above the main aisle of the Chapel. The project, unique in the United States, is designed to foster a dialogue between the world of faith and the world of contemporary art. It necessitates that worshipers encounter their sacred space in a new way. The project is modeled after the Kunst-Station Sankt Peter, in Cologne, Germany, a functioning parish that also serves as a center for contemporary art and music. Kunst-Station founder, Rev. Friedhelm Mennekes, S.J. [<http://www.artandreligion.de/data/index.php>], a former visiting international Jesuit fellow at Holy Cross, is shepherding the project here.
